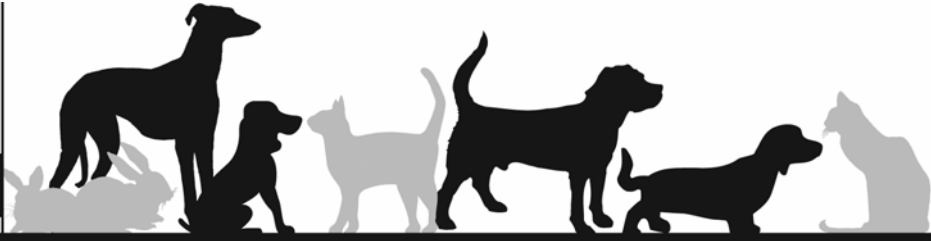




Dog Training



CLASSES AND DATES OFFERED:

Basic: (SMALL BREED dogs 4 months and older – 30 lbs. or less when fully grown)

Wednesday: **Orientation Oct 29 from 7-9 p.m.**, Nov 5 - Dec 10 class weeks 2 through 6 from 7:30-8:30 p.m. (skip Nov 26)

Thursday: **Orientation Wed Oct 29 from 7-9 p.m.**, Nov 6 – Dec 11 class weeks 2 through 6 from 6:15-7:15 p.m. (skip Nov 27)

Basic: (all dogs [any size] 4 months and older)

Monday: **Orientation Oct 27 from 7-9 p.m.**, Nov 3 – Dec 8 class weeks 2 through 6 from 6:15-7:15 p.m. (skip Nov 24)

Intermediate: For dogs who have completed a basic training class.

CLASS DESCRIPTION:

Basic: You will learn how to understand dog behavior and be a fair and effective leader, teach your dog sit, down, stay, come, pay attention to his or her name, walk politely on leash, wait at doors/gates, and shake. We will address behavior issues such as jumping, barking, digging, and chewing; appropriate toys; exercise needs; and interactive games. **Your dog will stay home the first week**, as this is an orientation for you. We will cover dog behavior, leadership, exercise needs, behavior issues, nutrition, and interactive games, and tell you what you will need to bring to class the following week when your dog comes with you. You are welcome to bring other family members to the class (children must be at least 10 years of age).

Intermediate: Go to www.sspca.org for a detailed class description. **Dogs attend all six weeks.**

CLASS FEES:

Basic: \$95 – 6-week session; \$80 dogs adopted from Sac. County or City shelters; \$70 dogs adopted from the Sac. SPCA

Intermediate: \$75 - 6-week session; \$65 - dogs who complete the basic or intermediate class at the Sac. SPCA

Senior Citizens: (60+ years) \$49.00 for any class

Refund Policy: Notification of cancellation must be received at least two (2) weeks prior to the first class session for a full refund. Cancellations received between two (2) weeks and 48 hours prior to the first class session will receive a 50% refund. No refunds will be given for cancellations less than 48 hours prior to the first class session or no-shows. Attendance of orientation and week 2 is mandatory for continuation in the class and no refunds will be given for drops.

*Early registration will confirm a place in class (class size is limited to 8 dog/handler teams). **Proof of vaccinations (rabies, distemper and parvo)** is required if your dog was not adopted from the Sacramento SPCA.*
